WHY SHOULD YOU INVEST IN SMS?

Investing in a SMS campaign is a great way to reach a large number of people very quickly. Over 90 percent of SMS are read in the first 3 minutes, making this method great for communicating invitations, alerts, and events as they're happening.

Texting also has a higher retention rate than email marketing - meaning you can conduct surveys with a higher likelihood of the recipient opening, reading, and responding. This can help with increased web traffic, social media subscribers, email sign-ups, and list building, especially ahead of blackout. Make sure to work on list building year-round!

GRANTS *Explained*

What is a grant?

A grant is a way the government can fund your ideas and projects to provide public services and stimulate the economy. Billions of dollars in federal grants are awarded each year.

Who's eligible?

Eligible organizations fall into several categories: state, county and local government; education; public housing authorities; nonprofits; larger for-profit companies and small businesses. There are very few grant opportunities open to individuals and none are for personal financial assistance. There are other resources for individuals seeking assistance to pay for their healthcare, education, disaster recovery and for finding government jobs and contract opportunities.

How do I find opportunities?

The best place to start is the Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance, which is an online database of all grant programs. You can use GRANTS.GOV to search, filter and apply for specific grants.

Getting Started CHECKLIST

- ✓ Familiarize yourself with the grant process including the pre-award, award and post-award phases.
- ✓ Learn about grant reporting requirements, including public disclosure, at usaspending.gov.
- ✓ Search for the specific grant you will apply for in the catalog on grants.gov.
- ✓ Confirm your eligibility for the grant by carefully reading the attached application instructions.
- ✓ Get a "unique entity identifier" assigned to all entities authorized to do business with the federal government via the System for Award Management at sam.gov.
- ✓ Once you have a UEI, return to grants.gov to continue your registration.
- ✓ Apply for the grant!

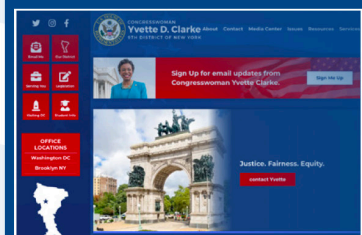

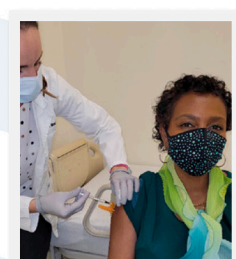
