In addition, Jaime Esparza also erected the El Paso Crime Victim's memorial in April 2009 and led a yearly memorial for victims who lost their lives to violent crime. Jaime Esparza is a person known to care very much for his community of El Paso, Texas.

As President of the Texas Gang Investigators Association, our executive board and members have had the opportunity to work and meet Jaime Esparza and his excellent staff of prosecutors. As summarized above, Jaime's years of knowledge and experience as District Attorney has played a major role in ensuring a better quality of life for the citizens of West Texas and has helped keep El Paso as one of the safest ranked cities in the United States for several years.
